Changes to bring this building back into use were given planning committee approval this week. The internal and external changes necessary to the building a future will enable a return to its use for weddings, registrar with the upper floors being used for a related small hotel.

Police Reminder: please do not to give to somebody begging on the street, it is a lot better to donate towards a homeless charity who they actively direct homeless people towards and work alongside.

Recently a male was reportedly begging outside shops on Central Avenue West Bridgford. This male had a CRASBO (criminally sought Anti-Social Behaviour Order) whereby he should not beg anywhere within the Nottinghamshire area. Due to him breaching this order he was arrested and remanded for court. He had in excess of £300 pounds in coins and notes in his pockets, we suspect from begging.

If you see somebody begging please ring 101 and report it to the police. They may have court orders in place whereby the person should not be begging and therefore could be arrested.
